Festulolium

Sebu Brand Festulolium is a highly palatable forage grass that offers the added benefits of superior heat and drought tolerance. It is persistent for several years of production. Sebu's feed value is like that of a tetraploid perennial ryegrass with a sugar content that is easily digested, encouraging livestock to gain energy for production of meat and milk. Sebu's yields are similar to a tetraploid perennial ryegrass.

Applications:

Sebu can be used for hay, grazing, greenchop, or silage. Plant Sebu as a stand along forage, or mix with legumes (like Seminole Ladino Clover) and other grasses to enrich the quality of the forage crop.

Seeding:

Plant Sebu at 30-50 lb. per acre or as part of a mix 20-25 lb. per acre. Planting depth of 1/4 to 1/2 inches deep. Broadcasting, use 50% more.
